JBT Tournament Rules:

1. JBT Tournaments are open to ALL junior bowlers not yet age 18 as of August 1, 2025.
2. Bowlers will use their highest 2025-26 average (min 8 games). If a bowler has not reached an 8-game average for the current season, he/she will use their highest book average. Once a bowler reaches 8 games within the 2025-2026 JBT tournaments, a JBT average will be used in each tournament.
 - a. **“Handicap 1”** Division is combined team average of 570 and below. The calculated average per baker game is a quarter of the combined team average. Handicap 1 is 90% of 190 with a maximum handicap of 70 pins per game for the baker games. The calculated team average during “regular” games, is the combined team average. Handicap 1 for the “regular” games is 90% of 570 with a maximum handicap of 210 pins per game.
 - b. **“Mixed Scratch / Handicap”** Division is any combined team averaging 571 or higher must bowl in the Handicap 2 division. The calculated average per game for the baker games is a quarter of the combined team average. Handicap 2 is 90% of 215 with a maximum of 21 pins per game. The calculated team average during “regular” games, is the combined team average. Handicap 2 for the “regular” games is 90% of 645 with a maximum handicap of 63 pins per game.
3. Bowlers in the Handicap Division must provide either a list of current leagues or verification (displaying average as of 1 week prior to tournament or last season bowled if not updated 1 week prior) from all leagues currently bowled during check-in. **Any bowler that does not provide written verification must bowl with an average of 215.** The tournament director reserves the right to rerate any bowler.
4. Dress Code: Collared shirts, long pants (dress or like-new blue jeans), dress shorts and skirts. The following is not allowed during the tournament competition: Hats, t-shirts, short shorts, miniskirts, cut off blue jean shorts, tank tops, clothing that is dirty or has holes in them, or shirts not covering the belly button. Violations will be determined at the director(s) tournament discretion. On the first dress code violation a bowler will be warned. On the second dress code violation the bowler will not be allowed to bowl.
5. Foul language, display of temper, or abuse of bowling center equipment will NOT be tolerated, and WILL result in immediate disqualification from the tournament. NO REFUNDS.
6. No cell phones, electronic devices, earbuds, or headphones are permitted in the Settee area.
7. Each tournament will accept entries on a 1st come 1st serve basis.
8. Score changes may only be made by a Rochester Youth Leader or tournament official.
9. Any bowler may choose to bowl in the mixed handicap/scratch division regardless of their average.
10. With an entry fee paid, each bowler acknowledges the JBT Tournament Rules. This acknowledges a mutual understanding of the rules provided and serves as a WARNING. If a bowler is in violation of any rules, he/she will be immediately disqualified for the current event unless he/she can rectify the situation before the start of the tournament. If the situation can't be corrected, the bowler will not bowl in the current event. Depending on the severity of the violation, further repercussions may result.
11. All rules not specifically covered will be governed by the rules of the USBC and the judgment of the tournament directors, who reserve all rights regarding the operation of the tournament.
12. No more than 18 teams will be allowed to bowl in the tournament. Pre-registration is recommended to ensure the teams entry

TOURNAMENT FORMAT:

- All teams will bowl 4 games across 8 lanes on the house condition of the given center.
- After 4 games, cut to half the entries per division to advance.
- All advancing teams will bowl 3 additional games.
- Total team pinfall for 7 games will determine the standings
