MARCH MADNESS ALIBI TOURNAMENT RULES:

- Tournament is open to all NYS USBC youth association certified bowlers that are current members of a 2024-2025 NYS USBC association certified league.
- Bowlers are required to bowl all 4 games, unless injured or unable to complete game 4.
- Bowlers will use their highest 2024-2025 average (minimum 30 games) as of March 1, 2025
 - a. Averages include ALL Jr Leagues, and High School. (Sport averages are not required unless it is the only average available and will be adjusted accordingly)
- Handicap 165 & under based on 90% of 165 (maximum of 58 pins per game), Handicap 166-195 based on 90% of 195 (maximum of 26 pins per game)
- Doubles Handicap teams will use the Handicap based on 90% of 195 (maximum of 87 pins per game)
- **Written verification of average MUST be presented at time of entry. Bowlers without verification must bowl scratch.**
- Dress Code: collared shirts or mock collared shirts, slacks, jeans (like-new and/or blue jeans), yoga/leggings style pants, plaids, cargo pants, dress shorts/skirts/skort, athletic shorts of appropriate length all permitted. No hats, no sweatpants and none of the above with holes, overly worn/ripped, soiled, etc., will be permitted.
- No CELL PHONES, ELECTRONIC DEVICES, EARBUDS(PODS) OR HEADPHONES allowed in the settee area.
- Foul language, displays of temper, or abuse of bowling center equipment will not be tolerated, and may cause immediate disqualification from the tournament. NO REFUNDS will be given.
- Each tournament will accept entries on a first come first serve basis.
- All rules not covered within will be governed by USBC
- All prize fees will be returned 100%, payable through SMART Scholarship Dollars.
- All 1st place scholarships are guaranteed for the singles event. All remaining prizes will be returned in the form of trophies/scholarship dollars with a ratio of 1:8 based on entries.
- All First-place scholarship dollars are estimated for the doubles events.
- Multiple participation: a bowler may enter the singles tournament up to 3 times. Cashing only once. A bowler may enter the optional doubles up to 4 times with the same partner, cashing only once with that partner, but can cash as many times as score indicates with change of partner.
- Tournament Directors have the right to adjust scores after bowling should verified average or other pertinent information become available that was not available at time of check in.
- Entries close April 18th, 2025 at 7:00pm.
