PROOF OF AGE IS REQUIRED

JOHN NEVADA MEMORIAL SENIOR MASTERS TOURNAMENT RULES AND INFORMATION

Eligibility: The Rochester Senior Masters is open to members of the Rochester NY USBC Association. Members of touching associations are welcome (Canandaigua, Finger Lakes, Genesee Region, Hornell, Penn Yan-Dundee and Lake Ontario/Wayne County) with a \$9 local association fee. Bowlers must have a minimum of 21 games bowled in the current bowling season in the same league and be at least 50 years old as of the starting date of this tournament to be eligible to bowl. All previous Rochester Senior Masters Champions and HOF members are eligible to bowl as long as they have a valid USBC membership card. Bowlers will be required to show their USBC membership card and proof of age upon request.

Format: This is a two-day, scratch event. There will be one 4 game qualifying round moving lanes after each game. Seeding for match play will be based on qualifying scores. Based on the number of bowlers in each division, the number of bowlers making the cut, will be calculated on a percentage basis for a total of 16 bowlers. In case of a tie for the last seed, a one game roll-off will be held to break the tie (if a tie still exists, a 9th and 10th frame roll-off will be held). In the event of a tie, the bowler with the highest qualifying game will be seeded higher. Lanes will be re-oiled for match play on Sunday. Match play will consist of single game matches with double elimination (bowlers being eliminated only after losing 2 matches). Ties in match play games will be broken with a 9th and 10th frame roll-off.

Check-in Procedure: Check-in will begin 60 minutes prior to tournament start. All entrants are asked to report 30 minutes prior to tournament start. Any individual failing to appear on the lanes when scheduled to bowl shall receive 0 for each frame missed. Tardy bowlers may begin bowling in the current frame when they are ready to bowl.

Dress Code: Proper bowling attire is required. NO hats, NO t-shirts NO sweatpants. Shirts must have sleeves and collars. Bowling ball company shirts with mock or banded collars of at least 1" in height will also be allowed. If you have questions, please reach out to the Tournament Director prior to the tournament.

Re-Rack Rule: A maximum of 2 re-racks per game will be allowed. Additional re-racks must be requested and will be awarded at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

Bowler of the Year Points: Participation in this tournament will count toward your point total in the Bowler of the Year award in your respective category. You will receive points for your highest finish position and for any honor scores bowled in this event.

Administration: The Tournament Director will resolve all disputes during the tournament. USBC Rule 12 will be in effect and enforced. Individuals in violation of the rule will be given (1) warning. If the violation continues, the bowler will be disqualified, and their entry fee will be forfeited. USBC rules not specified here will be in effect

Entry Fee Distribution: Prize fee will be returned 100%. Prizes will be awarded 1 for every 4 entries. A Prize check, entry to the NYS Senior Masters Tournament, and a choice of a Champion's Crystal Pin or a Championship Ring will be presented to the Senior Masters Champion. Champions will also receive a personalized banner to be hung at all future Senior Masters events.

Entry fees will be allocated as follows (\$30.00 charge on all returned checks):

Prize Fee: \$50.00

Bowling Expense: \$18.00

Tournament Expense: \$7.00

Total Entry Fee: \$75.00 (Late Entry Fee additional \$15 will be added to the prize fund)
